

What is the aim of PolArt Inc.?

The main aim of PolArt Inc. is to oversee the organisation and financing of each new PolArt festival by drawing on the accumulated knowledge and experience gained over 40 years.

Who is eligible to belong to PolArt Inc.?

Any Folkloric Dance Ensemble or Artistic Organisation in Australia and New Zealand that has participated in a previous PolArt festival and has at least 10 members is eligible to apply to belong to PolArt Inc.

What is the benefit of belonging to PolArt Inc.?

PolArt Inc. serves to support and facilitate collaboration between the large family of ensembles and artistic organisations in Australia and New Zealand. Your group will have access to knowledgeable people who can offer guidance and advice on a wide range of related topics. Whether or not you are involved in hosting the event, PolArt Inc. will ensure that your group's participation in the next PolArt festival will be a highly successful and positive experience. Belonging to PolArt Inc. is also the best way for your group to ensure the future of the festival for generations to come.

What does it cost to belong?

Currently there is an option to pay one triennual fee of \$250 AUD or three yearly instalments of \$90 AUD each. The fee currently covers all administration and secretarial costs for PolArt Inc.



PolArt beginnings - "Art Pol" Sydney 1975

Art Pol '75 was the first National Polish Arts Festival to present a full range of arts, crafts and culture from the Polish Communities in Australia. The brainchild of the Australian and New Zealand Union of Polish Women, it was organised by them and held in Sydney from the 27th December 1975 to the 1st of January 1976.



- The first PolArt Festival was titled "Art-Pol 75" and was held in Sydney
- It lasted 6 days between 27/12/75 01/01/76
- The festival featured Polish theatre, seminars, literature, a market, sports, music, art exhibitions, films, workshops, a New Year's ball plus an impressive Folkloric Dance concert held at the Sydney Opera House

- The festival received international recognition
- Ensembles and guest artists came from greater Australia including Hobart
- The folk ensemble from Hobart as well as Tatry, Polonez, Mazury, Kujawy, Pomorze, Wisla, Syrenka, Krakowiak, participated in the "Wielki Finał" directed by Feliks Lis at the Folkloric Concert
- The spectacular show at the Sydney Opera House also included a mandolin orchestra, choirs and soloist singers
